Suspect in attempted Burr Ridge break-in is charged with theft

The Burr Ridge Police Department charged Tony Keorkunian, 46, of the 900 block of Victory Lane, Justice, with motor vehicle theft and criminal damage to property Aug. 26, after a woman saw a man trying to force open a window of her Burr Ridge home at about 10:20 that morning.

The woman called the police, who responded to her home on 59th Street between Grant and Madison streets, said Burr Ridge Deputy Police Chief Marc Loftus. The woman had heard a noise, went to investigate and saw a man outside a ground floor window, Loftus said.

When the man saw her, he ran west toward Madison Street.

"She gave us a really good description," Loftus said.

About the same time, the Burr Ridge police learned Hinsdale police were looking for a man with the same description, related to an incident in Hinsdale, Loftus said.

Hinsdale Police Sgt. Mark Kenkun Wodka said someone reported an attempted burglary on the 200 block of West 59th Street in the Hidden Lakes apartment complex.

"We set up an area to search and called for a police dog," Loftus said.

Hinsdale, Indian Head Park, Clarendon Hills and Willowbrook police officers, along with a canine officer from the Cook County Sheriff's Police helped search for the offender.

The police also asked District 181's Elm School, which is on 60th Street just west of County Line Road in Burr Ridge, to follow the shelter in place plan,

the shelter in place plan, which means the students stay in their classrooms and nobody is allowed in the school. Burt Ridge police then received a

report of a landscaping truck stolen from the 6000 block of Grant Street.

Based on witnesses' descriptions of the suspected offender and the direction of travel, officers expanded their search, Loftus said.

Burr Ridge detectives located Keorkunian, who matched the suspect's description, on the 1700 block of 55th Street in Western Springs.

Keorkunian was taken into custody at 12:30 p.m. and subsequently charged with motor vehicle theft, criminal damage to property, theft and driving with a revoked license, Loftus said.
