MINUTES OF THE SPECIAL MEETING OF THE MAYOR AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF WILLOWBROOK HELD ON MONDAY, DECEMBER 19, 2016 AT THE BURR RIDGE POLICE DEPARTMENT, TRAINING ROOM, 7700 COUNTY LINE ROAD, VILLAGE OF BURR RIDGE, DUPAGE COUNTY, ILLINOIS.

1. CALL TO ORDER

The meeting was called to order at the hour of 6:30 p.m. by Mayor Frank Trilla.

NEW BUSINESS

6. ORDINANCE - AN ORDINANCE GRANTING A SPECIAL USE FOR A PLANNED UNIT DEVELOPMENT, INCLUDING APPROVAL OF PRELIMINARY AND FINAL PLAT OF PUD, GRANTING CERTAIN WAIVERS FROM THE ZONING ORDINANCE, GRANTING CERTAIN VARIATIONS FROM THE SUBDIVISION REGULATIONS, GRANTING APPROVAL OF A PRELIMINARY AND FINAL PLAT OF SUBDIVISION, AND RELATED MATTERS - PC 15-08: 820 PLAINFIELD ROAD - PETE'S FRESH MARKET

Planning Consultant Franco related that this PUD will allow for the repurposing of the old K-Mart into a multi-tenant commercial building. This PUD does not include the gas station at the northeast corner of Route 83 and Plainfield Road. There will also be an outlot building on the south side of the parking lot and will include a mix of restaurant and retail-service uses.

Planning Consultant Franco advised that the two current entrances off of Plainfield Road will be consolidated into one entrance across from the main entrance to the Willowbrook TownCenter. This entrance will have a traffic signal installed.

Planning Consultant Franco stated that there will be two access points off of Route 83. An existing median break will be used for southbound Route 83 access into the complex.

The Route 83 and Plainfield Road intersection will be expanded to include additional left turn lanes on Plainfield Road. The off-site improvements will be installed by the developer as part of the project.

Planning Consultant Franco reminded the Board that this project had originally gone through the zoning process in December of 2015, and was brought before the Board in January of 2016. One of the main reasons for the delay has been the need for the developer to obtain a portion of the property to the north of the development along Route 83 and also obtain easement rights from IDOT pertaining to another parcel.

Planning Consultant Franco advised that the property owner has signed an at-risk agreement that states that any work completed prior to the execution of the lease agreement with IDOT is at their own risk.

Planning Consultant Franco introduced Eugene Grzynkowicz, who is a representative of Pete's Fresh Market.

Trustee Berglund questioned who was responsible for the installation of the stop light at the entrance on Plainfield Road. Administrator Halik advised that all of the on-site and off-site improvements are the responsibility of the developer. Administrator Halik stated that there is an agreed-upon incentive arrangement that will be brought before the Board once the IDOT lease provision is approved. The Village will contribute some funds to help offset some of the costs.

Trustee Neal asked if the signalization will be addressed at the Route 83 and Plainfield Road intersection. Administrator Halik advised that the traffic signals will be interconnected when the new traffic signal is installed.

Trustee Mistele questioned when the opening date might be. Mr. Grzynkowicz advised that it anticipated to be completed in the Fall of 2017.

Administrator Halik reminded the Board that at the last Village Board meeting, a Village-wide travel and expense policy was adopted. This action was required for non-home rule municipalities.

The newly adopted policy references IRS reimbursement rates for mileage and meals for attending required training. The current Police Collective Bargaining Agreement references prevailing rates for mileage and state rates for meal reimbursements. State reimbursement rates are lower than the IRS rates.

Although the Village is not required to, it was agreed that the new reimbursement rates should be offered to all employees regardless of union or non-union status. After discussion with the police union representatives, a memorandum of understanding (MOU) was drafted by the IFOP and was reviewed and approved by the Village's labor attorney.

Adoption of the resolution will serve to approve the MOU in order for the police union members to receive the same reimbursement rates as all employees without opening the current contract.

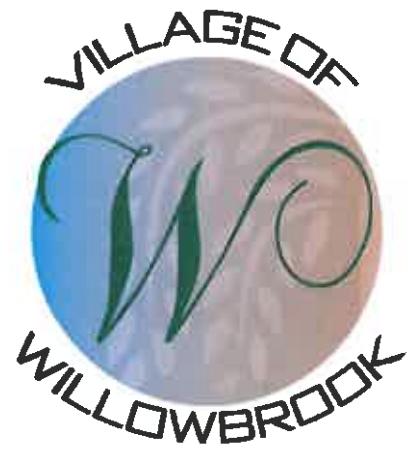

#### ITEM HISTORY (PREVIOUS VILLAGE BOARD REVIEWS, ACTIONS RELATED TO THIS ITEM, OTHER HISTORY)

The Village has adopted the DuPage County Countywide Storm Water and Floodplain Ordinance, with local amendments, for stormwater and floodplain management within town. The Ordinance requires that all drainage swales, storm sewers, and detention/retention areas on private properties are located upon easements. Therefore, upon a development of a property where re-grading work or other storm sewer installation occurs, new easements must be dedicated if they do not already exist.

#### ITEM COMMENTARY (BACKGROUND, DISCUSSION, KEY POINTS, RECOMMENDATIONS, ETC.)

The existing residence upon the property located at 6710 S. Madison Street has been razed and a new residence will be constructed in its place. The project will require re-grading of the property to establish positive drainage to serve the new residence. The re-grading will ensure that drainage from the property does not sheet flow onto adjacent properties. In accordance with the above-mentioned code requirement, new easements are required, since easements do not already exist. The owner's engineer has prepared a Plat of Easement dedicating new public utility and drainage easements for this purpose.

This particular property contains regulatory floodplain and floodway areas, in that a stream crosses it. Therefore, it was determined by the Village consulting engineer that the north periphery easement should be located south of the stream, outside of any floodplain/floodway areas. In this manner, if the utility easement is used to provide utilities to serve the new residence they would not need to cross the stream.

The Plat was reviewed and approved by the Village consulting engineer.

### ITEM HISTORY (PREVIOUS VILLAGE BOARD REVIEWS, ACTIONS RELATED TO THIS ITEM, OTHER HISTORY)

The public bid opening for the Lake Hinsdale Park Renovation Project occurred on August 18, 2016 at 2:00 PM. A total of four (4) sealed bids were received prior to the deadline with the low bid received from George's Landscaping d/b/a GLI Services, Inc. in the total amount of \$79,063. The Village Board awarded a contract to George's Landscaping at their regular meeting on August 22, 2016. The signed resolution and executed contract was then sent to George's Patecki, President of George's Landscaping, via Fed-Ex on August 23, 2016 to be counter-signed and returned. A pre-construction meeting was held on September 6, 2016 at 9:30 AM at the Village Hall. The start of this project was delayed due to the contractor needing to finish contract work in other locations.

### ITEM COMMENTARY (BACKGROUND, DISCUSSION, RECOMMENDATIONS, ETC.)

Work began in November and is now substantially complete pending the installation of the playground and shelter structure. The contractor has submitted a request for partial payment. The following is a breakdown of the project costs to date:

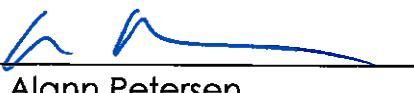

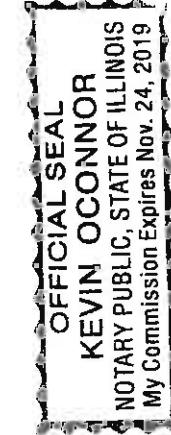

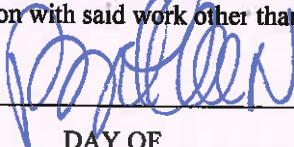

### ITEM HISTORY (PREVIOUS VILLAGE BOARD REVIEWS, ACTIONS RELATED TO THIS ITEM, OTHER HISTORY)

In November 2016, property owner Rosemary Bauman submitted a petition for annexation to annex her property at 122 59<sup>th</sup> Street to the Village of Willowbrook in order to connect to Village water services. Her property is located on the north side of 59<sup>th</sup> Street between IL Route 83 and Clarendon Hills Road. The property is approximately 0.28 acres in size and contains a single-family residence and detached garage. The subject property is bordered by incorporated residential properties to the east and to the north; however, the property just west of the subject property is unincorporated.

### ITEM COMMENTARY (BACKGROUND, DISCUSSION, RECOMMENDATIONS, ETC.)

As part of her application for annexation, Ms. Bauman submitted a plat of annexation, which has been reviewed and approved by the Village Engineer. The lot and the home, which will be annexed into the R-1 Zoning District, does not comply with minimum lot area, minimum lot width, minimum front yard setback, and minimum interior side yard of the R-1 Zoning District, but as an existing platted lot of the Woman's Subdivision of Lot 7 of Hall's Subdivision, these bulk dimensions will be considered legal non-conforming.

**ACTION PROPOSED:** Approve the ordinance annexing the property at 122 59<sup>th</sup> Street.

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING TERRITORY TO THE VILLAGE OF

WHEREAS, there has been duly filed on or about November 21, 2016 with the Village Clerk of the Village of Willowbrook, DuPage County, Illinois, a Petition under oath requesting that the territory described on Exhibit "A" attached hereto and made a part hereof (the "SUBJECT REALTY") be annexed to the Village of Willowbrook; and,

WHEREAS, said Petition was presented to the Village pursuant to the provisions of 65 ILCS 5/7-1-8; and,

WHEREAS, said Petition has been signed by all of the owners of record of the SUBJECT REALTY and no electors reside upon the SUBJECT REALTY or, in the alternative, the Petition was signed by more than fifty-one percent (51%) of the electors residing on the SUBJECT REALTY; and,

WHEREAS, the SUBJECT REALTY is not within the corporate limits of any municipality and portions thereof are contiguous to the corporate limits of the Village of Willowbrook; and,

WHEREAS, the statutes of the State of Illinois provide that upon the filing of such Petition, the corporate authorities of the Village of Willowbrook may pass an Ordinance annexing said territory to the Village, if said Ordinance is passed by a majority vote of the corporate authorities; and,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Board of Trustees of the Village of Willowbrook, DuPage County, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION ONE: That the SUBJECT REALTY be and the same is hereby annexed to the Village of Willowbrook, DuPage County, Illinois, together with all adjacent streets and highways contiguous to said territory, so that the new boundaries of said territory annexed shall extend to the far side of said adjacent streets and highways not within the corporate limits of any other municipality.

SECTION TWO: That the Village Clerk shall and is hereby authorized to file with the County Clerk of DuPage County, the Recorder of Deeds of DuPage County and the DuPage County Board of Election Commissioners, certified copies of this Ordinance together with an accurate map of the territory annexed appended thereto, attached hereto as Exhibit "B".

SECTION THREE: That all ordinances and resolutions, or parts thereof, in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are, to the extent of such conflict, expressly repealed.

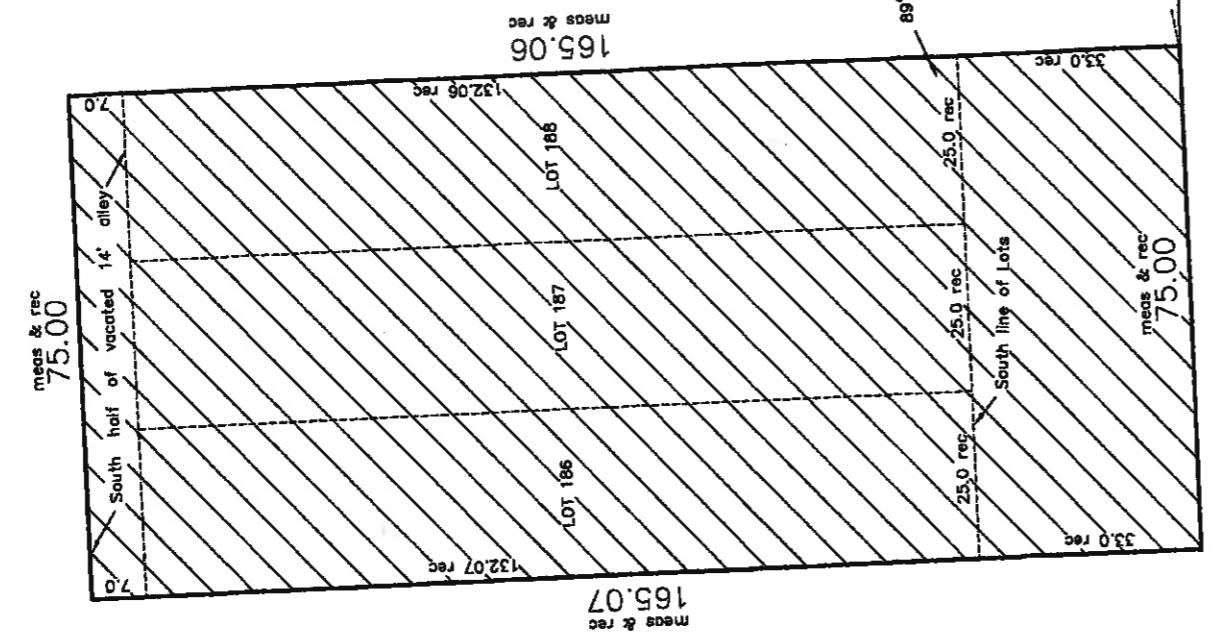
