Willowbrook Police Department releases Fourth of July enforcement numbers

Willowbrook, IL – **The Willowbrook Police Department** issued 18 speeding citations, 9 distracted driving citations, 1 seatbelt citation, and 9 other citations during the recent Fourth of July “Drive Sober or Get Pulled Over” and “Click It or Ticket” safety campaigns.

The Willowbrook Police Department joined forces with more than 200 other state and local law enforcement agencies to get drunk and drugged drivers off our roads and encourage seat belt use. The effort featured high-visibility enforcement combined with a variety of outreach activities including a media campaign.

The enforcement period was funded by federal traffic safety funds administered by the Illinois Department of Transportation as part of the statewide “Drive Sober or Get Pulled Over” and “Click It or Ticket” programs.

BACKGROUND

We currently do not send parking/compliance violations to the circuit court and merely rely on our collection agency to collect the fines. Even if parking and compliance violations were sent to the circuit court the Village would only receive a small portion of the fine assessed. In those cases, the fines are paid to the circuit court and not the Village. The procedures and notice requirements for administrative adjudication of parking and compliance violations are set forth at 625 ILCS 5/11-208.3. One hundred percent of the fines assessed are retained by the Village. Regarding scofflaws, the Village can adopt a vehicle immobilization ordinance and apply it retroactively. Those requirements are also codified at section 11-208.3 of the IVC.


