Willowbrook Police Department Releases Thanksgiving Enforcement Numbers

Willowbrook, IL – The Willowbrook Police Department issued 8 seat belt citations during the recent Thanksgiving enforcement effort.

The Willowbrook Police Department also took the following enforcement actions.

- 1 suspended/revoked license
- 1 uninsured motorist
- 2 speeding citations
- 4 miscellaneous driving citations

Law enforcement agencies throughout Illinois participated in this effort to save lives by getting impaired drivers off the roads and more people buckled up. The enforcement campaign took place from Nov. 19 through Nov 29.

During the mobilization, extra emphasis was placed on enforcement during late-night hours, when statistics show the most unbuckled and impaired driving fatalities occur.

The Thanksgiving enforcement effort was made possible by federal traffic safety funds administered by the Illinois Department of Transportation.

On 11/30/21 at 1550 hours, Willowbrook officer(s) were dispatched to Target, 7601 Kingery Highway for a retail theft that had just occurred. Upon arrival, officers located a vehicle exiting the Target lot which matched the description provided by Target asset protection. On Sunday, December 19th, 2021, at approximately 7:32pm, Officer Opacian and Officer Vanderjack were on patrol near Target when they encountered a suspicious vehicle driving through the lot with its front and rear license plates obstructed. During the follow up investigation, Officers Opacian and Vanderjack were able to link the two identified individuals to multiple retail thefts outside of Willowbrook. The case was turned over to the appropriate jurisdictions and charges for the individuals are pending.

Officer Opacian and Officer Vanderjack should be recognized for their hard work and attention to detail. Their diligence in seeing this case through until the end, not only prevented a crime from occurring in Willowbrook but also led to the apprehension of two criminals for another jurisdiction.


