Republic Services has issued the following changes to their normal waste collection services:

Why are changes occurring? REPUBLIC WASTE COLLECTION SERVICES, along with other companies within the industry, have announced changes in their collection services in order to protect and minimize their employee's exposure during the national response to COVID-19 while maintaining services to the general public.

Who is this notice for? All single dwelling residences in Willowbrook that are serviced by Republic Services.

What are the changes Republic Service collectors be taking? Beginning Monday, March 30 Republic will only pick-up:

- Carts with closed lids
- Garbage bags that are securely fastened

What won't they be picking up? Until further notice Republic Services will no longer be taking:

- Open bags
- Overflowing carts
- Bulk items: No white goods, washers, dryers, furniture and/or similar large items or any loose items.

Any other changes? Yes. Yard waste pickup has also been suspended.

And the date this takes effect is? Monday, March 30, 2020

What if I live in a Home Owner's Association, does this affect me? Please consult with your individual Home Owners Association for guidelines and changes they may be receiving from whatever trash and waste haulers your association has contracted with.

When will we be returning to normal pickup services? The Village of Willowbrook will continue to keep their residents posted to any additional changes in collection services and appreciate every resident's assistance as we all make adjustments during these trying times to protect all the employees that serve our community.
