



CIP OPEN HOUSE

A Capital Improvement Program (CIP) is a financial planning, budgeting, and management tool that calls for strategic investments in the Village's infrastructure, such as roads, sidewalks, water lines, public facilities, and equipment. The CIP also includes projects pertaining to heavy machinery, building improvements, vehicles, and repairs. These projects are largely funded by the General Fund, Water fund and grants.

The Village is planning on hosting a CIP Open House in February at the Village's new Community Recreation Center! Visit the following webpage, where a date for the CIP Open House will be announced:

Sidewalk installation at Gower West Elementary School:

The installation of a sidewalk on the east side of Cherry Tree Ln that will allow students and parents to more safely walk to and from the school.

Executive Drive Stormwater Project:

The installation of stormwater trapping materials under Executive Dr to prevent flooding during major rain and storm events. Staff are pleased to report that this project's timeline was reduced from three years to one, additionally, the expected cost of the project has been reduced from \$4 million to \$2.5 million.

Midway Park Improvement Project:

If approved by the Board, the Midway Park Improvement Project would begin in May 2023 and would be completed by the summer/fall 2023. This project would include the installation of a multi-sport/hockey rink installation, 8 Pickleball courts, a pavilion and restroom station, and a new parking lot encompassing 70 parking spots.

Borse Park Improvement Project:

The scale of this project will likely take three to four years based on funds available. Currently, Village staff are proposing Phase I of the project to begin in May 2023 and finish by fall 2023. The first phase will include stormwater drainage and infrastructure improvements, the installation of a permeable parking lot, and the installation of a park bandshell.

Creekside Park Improvements:

This project will include an upgrade of three pedestrian bridges at Creekside Park. The bridges were installed several years ago and due to deterioration, staff have determined the bridges are in need of upgrades in 2023.



Obtain a Park Permit Application and Fee Schedule in person from the Village Hall. You may also obtain an application online at www.willowbrookil.org. Just click on Parks and Recreation and go to the Park Permits link. There you will also see the permit fee schedule.

If your place and date are available, we can reserve it for you up to 7 days in advance in order to give you time to submit the application and the entire permit fee. The Village Hall is open Monday through Friday from 8:30A - 4:30P. You may also fax the application to the Village at (630) 323-0787 and then call to pay by credit card.

PARK PERMIT PROCEDURES

Residents and others can reserve park shelters and other areas for family outings, picnics, and corporate events.

HOW TO OBTAIN A PARK PERMIT:

1. Review the usage policy and fee schedule
2. Call the Village Hall at (630) 323-8215 to determine that the date and facility you desire are available; facilities can be reserved for up to seven days
3. Submit a permit application (PDF) along with your payment

Your reservation is complete when you receive the approved permit and the rules relating to the use of the park facilities.

ONLINE BILL PAYMENTS

The Village of Willowbrook now accepts online bill payments as a method to pay for park permits. You must contact the Village Hall to register prior to making a payment. A small convenience fee will be charged for this service: credit cards will be charged \$3.95 and debit cards will be charged \$1.95 per transaction. Official Payments, the service provider, charges this convenience fee for processing each transaction. This fee is not charged by or paid to the Village of Willowbrook.

The Village of Willowbrook treats park vandalism very seriously and prosecutes offenders to the full extent of the law. Your cooperation and diligence will be a great assistance in our efforts to make our parks as safe and attractive as possible. Registration PROCEDURES

REGISTER online, in person or by mail. Resident registration (mail-in or drop off) begins as soon as you receive your guide.



ONLINE • WWW.WILLOWBROOKIL.ORG The Village of Willowbrook Parks and Recreation Department online registration through ActiveNet. You can now access the website to register for all Recreation and Active Adult Programs offered by the Village. If you have a current ActiveNet household set up, you are able to register right away. If you are new to ActiveNet, you will need to create a new household before you can register.

ActiveNet is a safe and secure system. From our website, click the register online button, and create an account that will be approved by staff. Simply browse to the program you would like, select and checkout. You will receive an electronic receipt after submitting your secure credit card payment.



IN PERSON • Choose the program(s) you wish to register for and fill out the registration form completely, making sure you indicate proper code numbers. Sign the Release/Hold Harmless and Emergency Treatment Form.



MAIL • Enclose your check, money order (payable to the Village of Willowbrook) or Visa/Mastercard or Discover number with signature along with the registration form and mail to: Village of Willowbrook, Parks & Recreation Department, 835 Midway Drive, Willowbrook, IL 60527

PROCEDURES

1. All Village of Willowbrook resident registration forms received before February 13 will be held and randomly processed as the first batch of registrations on February 13. Non-resident registration begins February 20.
2. If a program chosen has an opening available, your registration is processed and a receipt confirmation will be mailed within approximately 5 working days.
3. If programs chosen have reached maximum enrollment, your name will be placed on a waiting list, and you will be notified. Every attempt is made to accommodate the persons on these lists. Please be sure to read through the receipt message carefully for an explanation of your registration status.

PROOF OF RESIDENCE

Policies set forth by the Village of Willowbrook Board of Trustees define a resident as anyone living within the boundary of the Village of Willowbrook. Anyone working or operating a business within the Village of Willowbrook boundaries, but living outside the boundaries shall not be considered a resident. We don't always recognize our neighbors; from time to time, we may ask to see proof of residence when you register for programs in person. All new residents must show proof of residency.

ACCIDENT POLICY

The Village of Willowbrook does not provide medical insurance coverage for injuries suffered while participating in Village programs, or while using park facilities. The Village therefore, can assume no responsibility for personal injury while participating in recreation programs or while using park facilities.

NON-RESIDENT FEE

Part of the cost of programs is assumed with tax dollars. Therefore, those who are not residents of the Village of Willowbrook will be assessed a non-resident fee. Non-residents pay an additional fee per program. Day Camp and Leagues may have different non-resident fee structures. See program for details.

ACCESSIBILITY

SATISFACTION GUARANTEED REFUND POLICY






