MAYOR'S MESSAGE - THE CRC

The Village of Willowbrook Board of Trustees and Staff held a Grand Opening event for the Community Recreation Center (CRC) on February 23. The new facility will tremendously impact Village operations. We built the facility to accommodate our growing Parks & Recreation Department and are excited to unveil the space to the public. The new building features a boardroom to host Board and Commission meetings, workshops, and other public events and a multi-use recreational space for various events and programming, such as the weekly Active Adults events. Additionally, the Recreational Services Coordinator, Carrie Navins's office will be onsite.

We could only finish a project of this size with the confidence and support of our community. The building and parking lot project began in early 2022. Engineering Solutions coordinated facility construction management and the General Contractor was E.P., Doyle & Sons. The total project cost for the renovation tallied \$2,000,000, with a significant grant of \$750,000 provided by the Illinois Department of Commerce & Economic Opportunity.
