
PARK IMPROVEMENT PROJECT UPDATES

Midway Park

Below is an approximate timeline of the Midway Park Improvement Project. Please remember that construction could be impacted by inclement weather and other potential variables outside the control of Village staff.

Contractors must follow the ordinance regarding hours and days of construction, which is only permitted during the hours of 7:00 am to 7:30 pm, Monday through Friday, and 7:00 am to 5:30 pm on Saturdays.

- **Phase I & II** - August and September 2023
Utility work and installation and rough grading of the property
- **Phase III** - September through November 2023
Park improvements and amenities
- **Phase IV** - October and November 2023
Permeable paver parking lot installation
- **Phase V** - December 2023
Final grading
- **Phase VI** - April 2024
Landscaping and fence installation

Borse Memorial Community Park

The first phase of the Borse Park Improvement Project will begin with the installation of the Eleanor Place permeable paver parking lot. This installation will take place in fall 2023.

Additionally, storm water infrastructure in the park will be replaced and upgraded in the fall following the conclusion of the BRW Fall softball season. These components of the project will enable future phases of the development to occur without major disruptions to park activities.
