PARK IMPROVEMENT PROJECT UPDATES

Project Open Houses

In an effort to receive extensive community feedback on various Capital Improvement Projects (CIP) for the summer of 2024, the Village will host three project open houses at the Community Resource Center (CRC) located at 825 Midway Drive. We invite all community members to join us.

• **Creekside Park - October 12, 2023**

This project will include a new playground with a pour-in-place rubber surface, a shade structure, and other leisure amenities.

• **Farmingdale - October 19, 2023**

This project will include a new playground with a pour-in-place rubber surface, a pathway, and other leisure amenities.

• **Borse Park Phase II - October 26, 2023**

This phase of the project will include an expanded walking path, a new pedestrian bridge, replacement/conversion of the current parking lot, and tree plantings and beautification. Additionally, the softball fields will be enhanced and new pickleball courts will be installed.

All open houses will be held from 5:00-7:00 PM.
