

Winter Reminders

Snow & Ice Removal

In an effort to keep the roads safe and clear this winter season, remember not to park on the street after 1" of snowfall. Also, remove empty refuse containers from the curb as soon as possible to avoid contact with snowplows. Please clear the storm drain covers, sidewalks, and fire hydrants near your property. If you encounter an inaccessible fire hydrant or snow piles that could obstruct a divers' views, report the location by calling 630-920-2238 or using the SEECLICKFIX Mobile App on your mobile device. Additionally, remember that it is against the Village Code to blow or place snow into the street as this causes hazardous conditions.



TEMPERATURE CONTROL

Residents who live in a rental unit or an apartment complex: the 2018 International Property Maintenance Code and The International Residential Code state that the minimum required temperature is 68°F during the heating months. Contact the Village for further questions.

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
