Kingery Highway pavement sealing begins June 3

CHICAGO – The Illinois Department of Transportation announced today that a crack and joint sealing of Kingery Highway (Illinois 83) from Ridgemoor Drive to north of 63rd Street, in Willowbrook, will require daily, intermittent lane closures beginning, weather permitting, Monday, June 3.

The project, which consists of routing, cleaning and sealing cracks along the 4.6-mile stretch of Kingery Highway to extend its useful life, along with new pavement markings, is expected to be completed in August.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to flaggers and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits and be on the alert for workers and equipment.

Over the [next six years](#), IDOT is planning to improve more than 3,000 miles of highway and nearly 10 million square feet of bridge deck as part of Rebuild Illinois, which is investing \$33.2 billion into all modes of transportation. [Accomplishments](#) through Year Four of Rebuild Illinois included approximately \$12.1 billion of improvements statewide on 5,339 miles of highway, 533 bridges and 762 additional safety improvements.
