Back to School Safety Tips

SLOW DOWN in School Zones

Please adhere to posted speed limits and be prepared for sudden stops. Remember, fines for speeding in school zones are substantially higher.

Be Vigilant Near Bus Stops

SLOW DOWN and be extra cautious near bus stops, where children may be waiting or crossing the street. Always stop when a school bus has its flashing lights on and the stop arm extended.

Watch for Pedestrians

Yield to pedestrians at crosswalks and stay alert, especially in areas where children are likely to be walking. Encourage children to use crosswalks and look both ways before crossing.

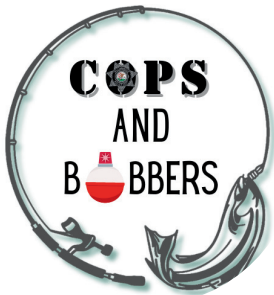
