As we wrap up our summer events, I would like to extend my sincerest appreciation for the support from our community. It was wonderful to see so many residents come out and participate in a variety of Village events and programming. As always, the Village has many exciting programs to offer in the coming fall and winter months, make sure you visit <https://www.willowbrookil.org/76/Parks-Recreation> to keep up to date on all offerings and find a program that interests you. From youth programs to our Active Adults community, the Village is proud to have offered over 130 programs this fiscal year alone!

The summer of 2024 was filled with a variety of accomplishments and successes that spanned all Village departments. Public Works successfully completed the Midway Park Renovation Project, Executive Drive Flood Control Project, Willow Pond Fishing Pier Restoration Project, and stormwater improvements to Brookbank Road. Meanwhile, Parks & Recreation successfully ran the inaugural youth and adult wiffleball leagues at Midway Park and oversaw several parks redevelopment projects including Farmingdale Terrace Park, Creekside Park, Midway Park, and Borse Memorial Community Park Phase II. As always, the Village prioritizes fiscal responsibility, demonstrated by our staff's ability to secure over \$1.3 million in grant funding for various portions of the Borse Park Redevelopment Project.

Finally, I want to bring attention to the retirement of a long-standing Village colleague. Village Clerk Deborah Hahn retired from her duties effective August 12th, 2024. Deb served as the Clerk from November 2020 to this past August. Prior to her time as Clerk, Deb was a valued employee within our Police Department from May 1987 to June 2018! Our Village offers immense gratitude to Deborah Hahn (Photo: top) for the variety of ways she helped serve her Village, we hope she enjoys a restful retirement, she certainly deserves it! 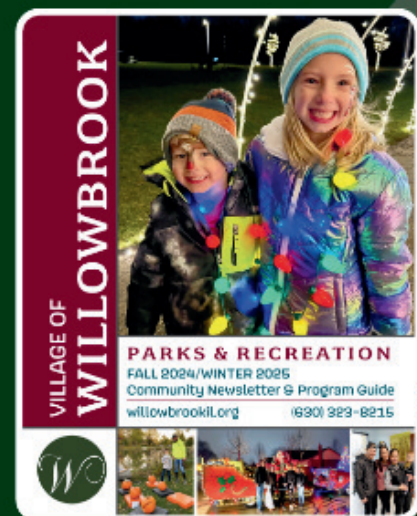
