Winter Reminders

Snow & Ice Removal

In an effort to keep the roads safe and clear this winter season, remember not to park on the street after 1" of snowfall. Also, empty refuse containers should be removed from the curb as soon as possible to avoid contact with snowplows. Please clear the storm drain covers, sidewalks, and fire hydrants near your property. If you encounter an inaccessible fire hydrant or snow piles that could obstruct a drivers' views, report the location by calling 630-920-2238 or by using the Conditions Report form at <https://www.frontlinepss.com/willowbrook>.


Remember that it is against Village Code to blow or place snow into the street as this causes hazardous conditions.

ComEd is also preparing for the winter months and reminding residents that transformers and switchboxes need at least ten feet of open space in front of the equipment's cabinet doors, and at least one (1) foot of clearance on the remaining three (3) sides of the equipment is necessary.

Winter Safety Driving Tips

- Slow Down and Increase Distance – Roads can be slick and unpredictable in winter weather. Drive slower and allow extra space between vehicles to prevent accidents. Even if roads look clear, they can be iced over, especially on bridges, shaded areas, and intersections.
- Clear Snow & Ice from Your Vehicle – Make sure your windows, mirrors, lights, and roof are fully cleared of snow and ice for maximum visibility.
- Equip Your Vehicle – Ensure your tires are winter-ready, and keep your gas tank at least $\frac{1}{2}$ full. Stock your car with essentials like a blanket, flashlight, and an ice scraper.
- Plan for Extra Travel Time – Allow for delays due to road conditions and consider postponing non-essential trips in severe weather.

Final Inspections are needed to ensure the work is completed to your satisfaction and meets Village code compliance to uphold public health, safety, and welfare.
