Frozen Pipe Prevention

Protect your home during the cold months by taking these simple yet effective steps:

- **Insulate Pipes:** Wrap exposed pipes with insulation to shield them from freezing temperatures.
- **Let Faucets Drip:** A small trickle of water can prevent pipes from freezing, especially during extreme cold.
- **Maintain Indoor Temperatures:** Keep your thermostat consistent, even when you're not home.
- **Disconnect Outdoor Hoses:** Remove and store hoses to avoid water freezing and damaging pipes.
- **Open Cabinets:** Allow warm air to circulate around pipes under sinks.

- **Inspect for Drafts:** Check your basement or crawlspace for drafts along exterior walls, especially near plumbing, to prevent freezing in colder areas.

Winter Safety Driving Tips

- Slow Down and Increase Distance – Roads can be slick and unpredictable in winter weather. Drive slower and allow extra space between vehicles to prevent accidents. Even if roads look clear, they can be iced over, especially on bridges, shaded areas, and intersections.
- Clear Snow & Ice from Your Vehicle – Make sure your windows, mirrors, lights, and roof are fully cleared of snow and ice for maximum visibility.
- Equip Your Vehicle – Ensure your tires are winter-ready, and keep your gas tank at least $\frac{1}{2}$ full. Stock your car with essentials like a blanket, flashlight, and an ice scraper.
- Plan for Extra Travel Time – Allow for delays due to road conditions and consider postponing non-essential trips in severe weather.
