Summer Driving Safety Tips


Summertime usually means vacations and summer road trips. Now is a good time to review these summer driving safety tips. A little planning and some safety checks might spare you from dealing with the consequences of a breakdown — or worse, a highway crash.

Make sure to check your air conditioning, belts/hoses, tires, cooling system, fluid levels, wiper blades, and lights to ensure they are working properly. If you need help, contact a licensed mechanic.

The National Highway Traffic Safety Administration (NHTSA) has a Recalls Look-Up tool (www.safercar.gov/recalls) which lets you quickly learn if your vehicle has a critical safety issue.
