As you enjoy the spooky season, we want to provide a few tips to ensure everyone stays safe and has fun.

For trick-or-treaters:

- Stick to well-lit areas and travel in groups.
- Cross streets at designated crosswalks and obey traffic signals.
- Wear reflective clothing or carry glow sticks to increase visibility
- Never enter a stranger's home.

For drivers:

- Slow down and be extra cautious, especially in residential areas.
- Be on the lookout for children who may be excited and darting between cars or into the street.
- Avoid distractions – keep your eyes on the road.

For homeowners:

- Keep pathways clear of obstacles for trick-or-treaters.
- Ensure your pets are secured to avoid accidents or fright.
